Letter articulation	Are letters coming from the correct articulation points?	☐	☐
Heavy and light letters	Are heavy and light letters being distinguished?	☐	☐
Vowels	Are short vowels being read clearly?	☐	☐
Sukun and Shaddah	Are consonants with sukun or shaddah being given their correct weight?	☐	☐
Madd	Is elongation being applied for the relevant rule?	☐	☐
Qalqalah	Is the echo sound controlled rather than exaggerated?	☐	☐
Noon and Meem	Are the relevant noon sakinah, tanween, and meem rules being recognized?	☐	☐
Pausing	Are pauses made at appropriate places without changing the intended meaning?	☐	☐
Restarting	Can the learner resume from the correct place after a pause?	☐	☐
Fluency	Can the learner continue with reasonable accuracy without guessing?	☐	☐

Five-step practice routine

1. Read a short passage at a comfortable pace.
2. Record one or two recurring issues.
3. Ask a qualified teacher to confirm the issue.
4. Practice one focused correction each day.
5. Review the same issue in the next lesson.
